About the Conference

The 27th Annual Conference of the Society of Statistics, Computer and Applications (SSCA) (<https://ssca.org.in>), is being organized by the Department of Statistics, North-Eastern Hill University, Shillong – 793022, Meghalaya on “Advances of Interdisciplinary Statistics and Applications in AI & ML (AISAAM-2025)” during February 21-23, 2025. The conference aims to bring statisticians, mathematicians, computer scientists working in diverse fields on a common platform to discuss and deliberate on topics and applications of regional and global issues. The conference is expected to facilitate the influx and exchange of ideas that would spur minds, both young and experienced, to come out with new innovative solutions for critical problems through statistical theory, applications, and computing. This will consist of a series of important talks, viz., Keynote addresses, prestigious Professor M N Das Memorial Lecture, plenary talks, and invited talks by eminent researchers and policy makers as well as young researchers, along with several sessions of contributory papers/poster presentations by the participants. The main highlight of the conference will be the J K Ghosh Memorial Endowment Lecture, the B K Kale Memorial Endowment Lecture, the Bikas K Sinha Endowment Lecture, the V K Gupta Endowment Award Lecture and the Aditya Shastri Memorial Lecture. Participants shortlisted for the Professor M N Das Memorial Young Scientist Award will present their research in a special session at the conference, based on which a panel of experts will decide the winner.

The abstract of the talk should be submitted online containing specific objectives of the study, methodology, and key results in MS Word format in not more than 500 words. The Host Institute: North-Eastern Hill University, Shillong (<https://www.nehu.ac.in>)

The North-Eastern Hill University (NEHU), a Central University, was established by an Act of Parliament (Act 24 of 1973), at Shillong, the capital city of Meghalaya. The prime objective was to set up a teaching and affiliating Institution for the hill areas of the North-Eastern Region (NER) in order to develop the intellectual, academic, and cultural background of the people of this region. The permanent campus of the university located at Umshing-Mawkynroh, Mawlai, Shillong, in the East Khasi Hills District is geographically surrounded by hilltops and pine trees, spread over twelve hundred acres of land area approximately. The university has established an outlying campus at Tura (South Garo Hills District), and a campus at Wahiajer, Jowai (Jaintia Hills District) called Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Community College. The university comprises eight schools consisting of forty seven academic departments and a centre of Distance Education. At present there are more than eighty undergraduate colleges affiliated to the University. The University Central Library has a collection of close to 2,00,000 books, 38,000 bound periodicals and it subscribes to 316 foreign and 366 Indian current journals. Our students are well placed and excel in various pursuits of life. Several teachers and students have been awarded with scholarships and fellowships by both national and foreign organizations. The percentage of our students qualifying the NET, GATE and other national tests is quite high. The number of students turning for their Master's degrees and research students working for their M.Phil. and Ph.D. degrees is close to 1,700. The undergraduate colleges affiliated to the University enroll about 60,000 students. The faculty strength of the university is a little over 300. In a short span of about 50 years, NEHU has matured into an institution with a serious academic, social and cultural agenda and a clear vision for its future growth.

How to reach NEHU

1. Train Route: The nearest railway station is Guwahati Railway Station/Kamakhya Railway station. From Guwahati station, taxis are available on reserved/sharing basis (about Rs. 500 per head or Rs. 2,500 for full cab) till Shillong, which is about 100 kms.
2. Air Route: Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport, Guwahati is 116 kms from NEHU campus (about Rs. 1,000 per head or Rs. 4,000 for full cab).

Guest houses, Hotels and Tourist Spots

- NEHU Guest House Guwahati, Near LGBI Airport, Guwahati, Assam. (Delegates who will reach Guwahati at late hours can avail this guest house facility for overnight stay by informing us).
- Many good hotels are available near the NEHU campus with price ranging from Rs. 1,200 to Rs. 8,000 per day.
