FAQs about the submission of paper

1. Are there any printing or processing charges for publishing research paper in Statistics and Applications (S&A)?

No. There are no printing or processing charges of a research paper in S&A. Publishing a paper in S&A is free. But we do insist on quality of contents. We discourage trivial applications of known theories or trivial corollaries or extension of known results. S&A is open access journal and one can view download and print full paper without any cost.

2. How much time does it take to complete the review process of a paper?

Normally, we expect to get the first set of comments from the reviewers within 8 weeks. The total time taken to arrive at a decision is about 16 weeks.

3. What is the time taken to print the paper once it has been accepted?

At present we have a long queue of accepted papers. So, the hosting of the accepted papers online at the website of the journal may take about 1 year or more. It takes further one more month to bring the issue in printed form. But we do host at the website a list of forthcoming accepted papers and provide acceptance letter to the authors when the paper is accepted. This list of forthcoming accepted papers is updated immediately a paper is accepted for publication.

4. How many issues are printed in a year?

We bring out two issues per year (or per volume). The first issue is hosted by 30 June every year and the second issue is hosted by 31 December every year. But we are happy to share that our journal is always hosted ahead of scheduled time.

5. What are the author's guidelines for preparing a research paper for possible publication in S&A?

The guidelines for preparing the manuscript are available at the website of the Society of Statistics, Computer and Applications (SSCA) on the journal page

(<https://ssca.org.in/> or <https://ssca.org.in/journal.html>). These are quite elaborate. The authors may read these carefully before preparing the manuscript of the paper. Initially the paper may be prepared either in MS WORD or in LATEX. The authors may submit both the source file and the pdf. After the acceptance of the paper, ONLY LATEX version of the paper will be accepted. The source files and the pdf of the accepted version maybe submitted as a .zip folder.

6. How do we get the LATEX template for preparing the paper, if available?

Yes, we do have LATEX template available with us. For getting the LATEX template, one can send a request for the template to sourish.das@gmail.com or durba0904@gmail.com or mandal.stat@gmail.com or bst0404@gmail.com. One may also download it directly from <https://ssca.org.in/journal.html>.

7. Where does one submit the manuscript?

The manuscript may be submitted to either sourish.das@gmail.com or durba0904@gmail.com and / or statapp1999@gmail.com through Email. At present, online submission is not possible.

8. What are important websites of the SSCA and the journal S&A?

9. What is the process/ guidelines for submitting a manuscript?

As such there are no rigid guidelines for the submission of manuscript. However, the paper to be submitted for possible publication must be accompanied with a covering letter, could be the Email itself, clearly mentioning

1. We are submitting this paper for possible publication in S&A.
 2. We have carefully read the guidelines of the journal.
 3. We have submitted this article to this journal (S&A) ONLY and it has not been submitted / accepted / published anywhere else.
 4. All the authors are willing to proceed with the process of publication

11. Does the journal encourage bringing out a special volume as a part of conference proceedings apart from society's (SSCA's) annual convention?

No, we do not entertain ANY request for publishing special issues comprising of conference proceedings. We do not provide any platform in our journal S&A to any conference proceedings. Even our own society's (SSCA's) conference proceedings are published as Special Proceedings and are not a part of the journal S&A. However, we do encourage publishing special issues on some important emerging theme. We appoint Guest Editors who invite established authors in the area of theme of the special issue, to submit their paper for this special issue. The papers undergo the usual stringent review process. The papers that appear in such special issues are by invitation only. Anyone can suggest some probable author to any of the Guest Editors or to the Chair Editors of the S&A. If found worthy, an invitation for submission would be extended to the name suggested.

12. What is the impact factor of the Journal S&A?

The journal S&A has been rated by the National Academy of Agricultural Sciences (NAAS) with a score of 6.30 effective 01 January 2025. ESCI Impact Factor is 0.3.

13. Is the Journal Indexed?

Yes, the journal S&A is indexed in (a) Web of Science {Emerging Sources Citation Index (ESCI)}; (b) Google Scholar; (c) included in UGC Care list (India).
