(Cash Award of Rs. 20,000.00 (Rupees Twenty Thousand only))

AWARD

- In order to identify and recognize talented and promising young scientists of Indian origin, possessing extraordinary originality and dedication to their research programmes, SSCA gives annually an individual award during its annual conferences.
- The award is popularly known as **M.N. Das Memorial Young Scientist Award (MNDM - YSA)**.
- The SSCA invites nominations from young scientists of Indian origin below the age of 35 years as on 01st January 2026 for MNDM YSA - 2026.

SUBMISSION

- Full length research paper (soft copy) along with an abstract not running in more than 200 words as a pdf along with the source file
- Passport bio-data in the prescribed Application Form, giving full name, date of birth (duly self-attested copy of certificate), affiliation, completed address for communication including Email and mobile number, research experience, list of publications (research papers in refereed journals, books, book chapters, monographs, etc.)
- **"No Objection Certificate"** from all the co-authors (wherever applicable), stating clearly that they have no objection in the research paper being considered for the **MNDM YSA - 2026**.
- A certificate from the author that the research has not been published or accepted for publication anywhere in India or abroad on the day of submitting the nomination.
- A passport size recent photograph.

NOTE: Papers shortlisted, as per the rules, after the review process is over, will be presented by the authors in person during the **28th Annual Conference** to be held at **Department of Statistics & Centre for Advanced Studies, Savitribai Phule Pune University, Ganeshkhind, Pune - 411007, India** during **January 5-7, 2026**.
